Step Inside a new Inpatient Room at JBH

Windows: Natural light and views of Lake Ontario or the escarpment from large windows will provide a comfortable, healing environment.



Patient Lift: Each room will be equipped with a ceiling mounted patient lift which is an important piece of hospital equipment used to assist in the transfer of patients with mobility issues to and from the bed.



Family Area: A dedicated family area will be furnished with sleeper chairs that easily pull out for comfortable accommodation.

Design: A warm and welcoming design to support patient care and wellbeing.

Hand Hygiene Station: Touch-free sinks are designed to minimize splashing and the spread of bacteria, meeting infection prevention standards. Hand sanitizer and glove containers ensure visitors and staff can practice proper hand hygiene when they enter and exit the room.



Private Washroom: Each single patient room will have private washroom with a shower. A wide doorway accommodates patients using a walker or wheelchair.
